

Bloodborne Pathogens in the Workplace

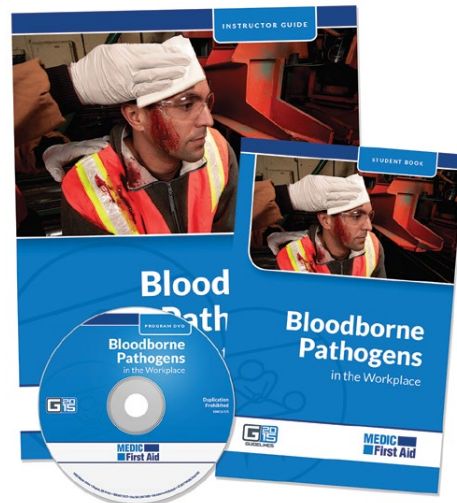
